

**CORRECTED REPORT**

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the establishment of the public streets being vacated, Mariondale Avenue and Lillyvale Avenue, as private driveways, Mariondale Avenue and Grifols Way.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. FIND that the name establishment is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, pursuant to Article III, Class 5(4) of the City's Environmental Guidelines.
2. FIND that the name of the public streets being vacated, Mariondale Avenue and Lillyvale Avenue, shown on Exhibit A of the City Engineer report dated June 22, 2021, attached to the Council file, be established as Mariondale Avenue and Grifols Way (Private Driveways).

**3. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to transmit the Council's action on this matter to:**

**a. The Board of Supervisors, County of Los Angeles, pursuant to Section 34092 of the Government Code.**

**b. The Los Angeles Department of Transportation, City-wide Investigation Section.**

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Engineer reports that a fee of \$4,628.82 was collected pursuant to Section 18.09 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code.
