

PERSONNEL, AUDITS, AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the 2021-22 Personnel Authority Resolution.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION granting personnel authority in accordance with Attachments A, B, and C of the August 16, 2021 City Administrative Officer (CAO) report, attached to the Council file, consisting of the following:

- a. Attachment A providing authority effective July 1, 2020, unless otherwise noted therein, for positions included in the 2021-22 Budget requiring temporary on-budget resolution authority.
- b. Attachment B providing temporary authority for the positions included in the 2021-22 Budget and the 2021-22 Proposed Detail of Positions and Salaries, pending the effective date of the 2021-22 Departmental Personnel Ordinances.
- c. Attachment C providing authority effective July 1, 2021, for positions that were approved by resolution during the 2020-21 fiscal year, which are funded off-budget and continue to be needed during 2021-22. In instances where departments are requesting continuation of resolution authority beyond current authorized periods of time, the CAO concurs with such requests contained herein.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the CAO. Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On September 1, 2021, your Committee considered an August 16, 2021 CAO report and Resolution relative to the 2021-22 Personnel Authority Resolution. According to the CAO, in accordance with the 2021-22 Budget, Attachment A lists the on-budget resolution authority positions to be authorized. Attachment B lists any classification and pay grade changes approved by the Personnel Department and the CAO, Employee Relations Division, subsequent to consideration of the Mayor's Proposed Budget. Attachment C lists the resolution authority positions to be authorized that are funded off- budget. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
