As part of the organization's commitment to serving specialized populations, Sycamores is also the lead organization for the Youth Coordinated Entry System in LA County Service Planning Area 3. First of all, we recognize your continued commitment to addressing homelessness in the City of Los Angeles. I am writing to respectfully ask you to support the immediate implementation of the Street Engagement Strategy (SES) . We are especially worried about the return to any failed enforcement led approach of criminalizing and displacing our unhoused neighbors. As a community-based provider serving young adults who are experiencing homelessness, we believe that the Street Engagement Strategy reflects the best practices of providers and different teams within public systems' to ensure that our unhoused neighbors continue to be treated with respect and dignity. The City Council has already committed to the Street Engagement approach last month and it must follow through on this promise. Right now, we are not on track to have a strategy in place by September 3rd when LA Municipal Code Section 41.18 goes into effect. This means an ad-hoc approach will begin, without clear protocols informed by best practices. Therefore, we urge you to move forward with adoption and immediate implementation of Street Engagement Strategy. Thank you for your consideration.
