Comments for Public Posting: Speeding has become endemic in our city and the design of our roads encourage this with their generous width and lack of navigation constraints. As a cyclist I find this especially menacing when cars pass within a few feet, sometimes at speeds of 50 mph and more. The most problematic examples of fast roads have attracted dangerous street racing. I strongly support this motion to explore and implement methods for clamping down on street street racing with traffic calming features that stymie this practice. Further, I encourage that traffic calming strategies be implemented citywide in order to provide persistent impediments to the scourge of speeding.
