ALEJANDRO SANZ

Since Alejandro Sanz's debut in 1991 with "**Viviendo Deprisa**," and his most recent studio album in 2019 "**El Disco**," Sanz has established himself as one of the best known and influential artists in the world, with more than 25 million albums sold. Of the 19 albums he released, all have reached multiplatinum status in Spain, Latin America and the United States.

He is also the Spanish artist who has received the largest number of GRAMMY® Awards (24 Latin Grammys and 4 American Grammys).

Throughout his career, Sanz has collaborated with different, well-known artists from all over the world, including performers such as: **Alicia Keys, Shakira, Destiny's Child, Laura Pausini, The Corrs, Ivete Sangalo, Emeli Sande, Juanes, Juan Luis Guerra, Marc Anthony, Alejandro Fernández** and the legendary **Tony Bennett**. The first single, "**Un Zombie a La Intemperie**," from his album "**Sirope**" (produced by Sanz and the renowned producer Sebastian Krys) reached Number 1 on iTunes charts in Spain, Latin America and the United States.

After a year of intense preparations, Sanz began 2017 with the presentation of "**MÁS ES MÁS**," a project that celebrates a very special year in his career as an artist. The culmination of this celebration was the spectacular concert that the artist gave on June 24, 2017 at the Vicente Calderon Stadium in Madrid, where attendees had the opportunity to once again experience the songs on his album "**MÁS**," as well as the major hits of his career. Sanz was surrounded by a stellar cast of friends, including Pablo Alboran, David Bisbal, Juanes, Vanesa Martin and Juan Luis Guerra, who accompanied him on stage during this magical and unique night.

The announcement of the event received more than 1 million views on Facebook in the first 24 hours since its initial publication, and pre-sales collapsed the Internet sales site. On February 3, Alejandro Sanz became the only artist who managed to sell out the entire the Vicente Calderon Stadium in the record time of 30 minutes.

In addition, Alejandro Sanz is currently the **Spaniard with the highest number of followers on Twitter (more than 19 million)**; along with more than 6 million followers on Facebook and 5.1 million followers on Instagram. He is one of the most influential people on social networks.

In 2013, Alejandro received the title of **Doctor Honoris Causa** from **The Berklee College of Music** in Boston, USA in recognition of his contributions to international music and culture. In 2017, he received the **la Medalla de Oro de la Comunidad de Madrid** (the gold medal from the community of Madrid) for his talent, his support for humanitarian causes and his ability to overcome obstacles. He also received the **La Medalla de Oro al Mérito de las Bellas Artes** (the gold medal for merit in Fine Arts) awarded by the Spanish Ministry of Culture, and the **Premio Vision** (Vision Award) awarded by the White House through the Hispanic Heritage Foundation in recognition of his notable contributions to Latin music.

Alejandro Sanz has also won several other awards, including: Ondas, 1 Billboard Award, various awards from Los 40 Principales, and Dial, as well as awards of international significance, such as several Gardel Awards, Oye Awards, Luna Awards and multiple recognitions in the world-famous Viña del Mar annual event.

Alejandro Sanz has also been acclaimed for his commendable involvement with non-governmental organizations, such as Médecins Sans Frontières, Save The Children and Greenpeace.
