PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed adjustments to the Police Commission Service Fee study for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 including, recommended fee decreases for three services: False Alarms, Information Cards, and Noise Variances; and, an increase for Press Passes.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST the City Attorney to draft the appropriate Ordinances to effectuate the proposed adjustments to the Police Commission Service Fees for Fiscal Year 2021-22, as recommended in the Board of Police Commissioners report dated May 11, 2021, as long as the current fee for Press Passes is maintained.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that approval of the proposed adjustments to the Police Commission Service Fees as recommended in this report are estimated to generate approximately \$10.6 million in net cost recovery for the services provided in FY 2021-22.

<u>Financial Policies Statement</u>: The CAO reports that the recommendation in this report is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that the proposed fees are deemed fair and recover the full cost of the services provided.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on September 1, 2021, the Public Safety Committee considered a CAO report relative to proposed adjustments to the Police Commission Service Fee study for FY 2021-22 and recommended fee decreases for three services: False Alarms, Information Cards, and Noise Variances; and, an increase for Press Passes. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Chair made a verbal amendment to the recommendation regarding the fee increases. The Committee then approved as verbally amended by the Chair the recommendation in the CAO report dated August 11, 2021, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to Council for its consideration.
