I waited over an hour and was denied a forum in which to express the objective facts of the findings. (Not opinions.)

The main reason I was holding was because I wanted CLARIFICATION. I want clarification of what you meant by striking the golf club from the historical designation as a revision to the item. As you know, you are REQUIRED to detail your rationale and substantiate your findings. Please to respond me in writing on this point. I would appreciate a prompt response today.

This meeting is not to debate whether or not the "subject property" qualifies for this nomination. It has been decided by the CHC staff and Commission that it does. This meeting is not about what the developer wants or promises. Whatever the future development might be should not be discussed at all today. The CHC staff report, written by experts and supported by our Councilman is for the entire "subject property", that is the only matter that is before you today and I strongly urge you to vote YES.

This is not progress in Studio City as many well-paid Harvard Westlake shills stated. I was one of many callers who were not able to offer public comment, given the limited time devoted to such this morning.

Briefly, I've lived in Studio City for 30 years, 25 of them next to the subject property, Weddington Golf & Tennis. I fully support the Commission's recommendation for the entire property to be preserved and given HCM status.

The HCM designation is no surprise as the subject property was deemed historic by Survey LA back in 2012. However, amendments introduced before and during today's meeting radically change the scope of the Commission's original determination back in April. Equally concerning were the calls this morning supporting future development plans and not staying on topic: the HCM.

Furthermore, these amendments exclude everything on the subject 16 acres for HCM protection except the putting green, club house, golf ball lights and brick wall. Well, that's akin to giving a majestic movie theater HCM status, preserving the marquee, box office and snack bar and bulldozing the rest. This is neither the time or the place for HCMs by fractions.

Therefore, I respectfully request the committee put aside past affiliations, relationships and donor histories and do the right thing: Forward item # 15 for a full City Council vote based on the Commission's original recommendation--not today's doctored one--and preserve the entire subject property, Weddington Golf & Tennis, with a full and deserved HCM status.

I would like to bring to your attention, however, that today's revisions are confusing and seem to contradict the original CHC staff report.
