Dear Honorable PLUM Committee:<BR><BR>While we are pleased that the PLUM Committee declared the entire Weddington Golf & Tennis subject property a Historic-Cultural Monument, we are disappointed that the Committee appears to have altered the full recommendation of the Los Angeles Cultural Heritage Commission. That recommendation recognized Weddington Golf & Tennis, otherwise known as Studio City Golf & Tennis Club, for its "combination of greenery, open space, social outlets, and community recreation". Only a facility that retains the characteristics of the current property AND is fully open to the general public can meet this criterion.<BR> <BR>As a property that for generations has been open to everyone regardless of age, gender, and ethnicity for an affordable price without membership dues. Weddington Golf & Tennis stands out for its planned landscape, specifically, the number and application of over 350 palm, eucalyptus, and pine trees, to define the fairways.<BR> <BR>Any proposed demolition of this excellent example of a post WW II Era recreational facility will result in a significant loss to the heritage of Studio City.
