## TO CITY CLERK FOR PLACEMENT ON NEXT

The Pipeline Franchise Revenue portion of the Real Property Trust Fund provides funding for street and sidewalk infrastructure improvements within each Council District. The Board of Public Works Office of Community Beautification is coordinating the efforts of the Los Angeles Conservation Corps for sidewalk repair services in Council District 15.

This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for Council District 15 and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the Pipeline Franchise Revenue portion of the Council District 15 Real Property Trust Fund for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$142,858 in the Pipeline Franchise Revenue portion of the Council District 15 Real Property Trust Fund No. 697 be transferred / appropriated to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74 Account No. 3040 (Contractual Services) for various street maintenance / sidewalk repair efforts and services by the Los Angeles Conservation Corps in Council District 15.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Public Works, Office of Community Beautification be authorized to prepare the necessary documents including any contract amendments, as appropriate, with and/or payments to the Los Angeles Conservation Corps, or any other agency or organization, in the above amount for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Public Works be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
