WHEREAS, on recommendation of Management, there was presented for approval, First Amendment to Contract DA-5318 with RS&H California, Inc. to extend the term by three (3) years, covering engineering services related to the Landside Access Modernization Program Roadways, Utilities, and Enabling Projects at Los Angeles International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment will allow staff to retain RS&H California, Inc. (RS&H), as the Designer of Record for the Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP) Signage and Wayfinding Package Phases 1 and 2 that are under construction through the Roadways, Utilities, and Enabling Projects (RUE) contract. RS&H is finalizing the design and permitting of both signage packages, which include installation of over 150 signs in each phase. Once permitting for each signage package is obtained, RS&H will provide design services during the construction phase to respond to Requests for Information, submittals, and other questions from bidders, contractors, permitting agencies, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the Phase 1 signage package is in the final stages of permitting, and the Phase 2 package is 85% complete. Retaining RS&H for an additional three (3) years to finalize the signage and wayfinding packages and provide design services during construction will allow for installation without delays; and

WHEREAS, this action, as a continuing administrative activity, is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements pursuant to Article II, Section 2.f. of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, RS&H is required by contract to comply with the provisions of the Living Wage Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Procurement Services has reviewed this action (File 8326) and established mandatory goals of 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE); 5% Local Business Enterprise (LBE); 3% Local Small Business Enterprise (LSBE), as a subset to LBE goal; and 3% Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE). RS&H pledged to said mandatory goals, and has achieved 50.06% SBE, 24.76% LBE/LSBE, and 2.46% DVBE to date; and

WHEREAS, RS&H is required by contract to comply with the provisions of the Affirmative Action Program; and

WHEREAS, RS&H is assigned Business Tax Registration Certificate 0002525836-0001-8; and

WHEREAS, RS&H is required by contract to comply with the provisions of the Child Support Obligations Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, RS&H has approved insurance documents, in the terms and amounts required, on file with Los Angeles World Airports; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 1022, staff determined that the work specified on the contract can be performed more feasibly or economically by an Independent Contractor than by City employees; and



WHEREAS, RS&H has submitted the Contractor Responsibility Program Questionnaire and Pledge of Compliance, and will comply with its provisions; and

WHEREAS, RS&H must be determined by Public Works, Office of Contract Compliance, to be in compliance with the provisions of the Equal Benefits Ordinance prior to contract amendment; and

WHEREAS, RS&H is required by contract to comply with the provisions of the First Source Hiring Program for all non-trade Los Angeles International Airport jobs; and

WHEREAS, RS&H has submitted the Bidder Contributions CEC Form 55, and will comply with its provisions; and

WHEREAS, RS&H has submitted the Municipal Lobbying Ordinance CEC Form 50, and will comply with its provisions; and

WHEREAS, actions taken on this item by the Board of Airport Commissioners will become final pursuant to the provisions of Los Angeles City Charter Section 373;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Airport Commissioners adopted the Staff Report; determined that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2.f. of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; approved the First Amendment to Contract DA-5318 with RS&H California, Inc. to extend the term by three (3) years, covering engineering services related to the Landside Access Modernization Program Roadways, Utilities, and Enabling Projects at Los Angeles International Airport; and authorized the Chief Executive Officer to execute said First Amendment to Contract DA-5318 with RS&H California, Inc. after approval as to form by the City Attorney and approval by the Los Angeles City Council.
