

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to accepting a grant award for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 Dispute Resolution Program from the County of Los Angeles Department of Workforce Development, Aging and Community Services for period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. Authorize the City Attorney or designee to approve the Standard Agreement with the County of Los Angeles Department of Workforce Development, Aging and Community Services for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
2. ACCEPT funding in the amount of \$137,810 from the County of Los Angeles Department of Workforce Development, Aging and Community Services to maintain operations.
3. APPROVE the City cash and in-kind match in the amount of \$34,453 for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.
4. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:
  - a. Establish a receivable within Fund No. 368 in the amount of \$137,810 from the County of Los Angeles.
  - b. Establish a new appropriation account within Fund No. 368 as follows:
    - i. Account No. 12V702 - DRP RJ Grant - \$137,810.
  - c. Transfer \$92,679 from Fund No. 368, Account No. 12V702 to Fund No. 100, Department No. 12, Account No. 001010, Salaries, General.
  - d. Upon receipt of grant funds, transfer up to \$40,379 from Fund No. 368, Account No. 12V702 to Fund No. 100, Department No. 12, Revenue Account No. 5346, Related Cost Reimbursements from Grants.
5. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), and AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO finds that the Grant complies with the City financial policies as follows: The total cost of FY 2021-22 Dispute Resolution Program Restorative Justice is \$172,263, of which \$137,810 will be reimbursed by the County of Los Angeles Department of Workforce Development, Aging and Community Services. The match requirement of \$34,453

will be satisfied through partial related costs (\$15,700) included in the 2021-22 Adopted City Budget and volunteer hours (\$18,753). The recommendations in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that budgeted appropriations will be balanced against grant receipts.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
