RESIDENT of Council District #8 Los Angeles Council District #8 is the only district with majority black(African American) in the city without any regional assets. Historically USC and Expo Park have been in CD8. These assets were removed from CD8 and move to CD9 in the last redistricting change back in 2011. This move had major economic impact on the district. As a resident of the district, I am very concerned with the proposal not to return these assets to CD8. With USC and EXPO Park being redrawn for CD8, CD9 will still have these major assets: Convention Center, Staples Center, LA Live and Ritz Carlton in its district. Why isn't the city trying to do the right thing? Why these last minutes adjustments to the MAP? CD9 lost assets to CD14 back in 2011. Why isn't the city looking at the losses from 2011 AND correcting the wrong that was done in 2011 to CD8 and CD9. RETURN USC and EXPO PARK back to CD8
