Summary: Canoga Park Neighborhood Council would like to express our strong preference that the final map to be adopted include boundaries for Canoga Park and adjacent areas specifying that Canoga Park be included in the same Council District with all of Warner Center, Woodland Hills, Winnetka, and Reseda, based upon the following considerations: 1. The suggested boundaries would allow for better coordination between the specific council member and contiguous neighborhoods and Neighborhood Councils concerning vital projects underway in the immediate area, such as the development known as Westfield 2035. 2. The areas designated herein include other neighborhoods with which Canoga Park has significant shared interests; The Council also decided to oppose any configuration which does not include the boundaries specified above, because the effect on our community would be deleterious due to many factors, including the following: 1. Other such alternatives placing Canoga Park outside the proposed boundaries would divide council representation within Neighborhood Council borders, creating bureaucratic difficulties and duplication of effort; 2. Other such alternatives placing Canoga Park outside the proposed boundaries would negate the benefits of numerous working relationships and alliances between communities over many years; 3. Other such alternatives placing Canoga Park outside the proposed boundaries would make communication and interaction more difficult. 4. Other such alternatives placing Canoga Park outside the proposed boundaries could sever connections with localities containing significant economic, cultural, and social assets which would be less likely to be available to the Canoga Park community. Therefore, The Canoga Park Neighborhood Council requests that the final boundaries adopted by the Los Angeles City Council specify that Canoga Park be included in the same Council District with all of Warner Center, Woodland Hills, Winnetka, and Reseda.
