

AD HOC REDISTRICTING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to Redistricting Proposals for the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) Board of Education.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the LAUSD Redistricting Commission's draft plan, as proposed in the Commission's report, "Report and Recommendations of the Los Angeles Unified School District Redistricting Commission," dated October 29, 2021, attached to the Council file, with the adopted agreed-upon adjustments between School Board Districts 5 and 7 [Appendix A of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) Report dated November 5, 2021, attached to the Council file], as the City Council's Draft Map for LAUSD district boundaries.
2. REFER the recommendations concerning future redistricting processes proposed by the LAUSD Redistricting Commission to the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Committee for further consideration.
3. INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering to prepare the metes and bounds for the adopted map and submit them to the City Attorney to support the necessary ordinance by November 29, 2021.
4. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present the necessary ordinance, no later than November 30, 2021.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CLA reports that there is no fiscal impact to the General Fund resulting from the recommendations in this report.

The Committee Chair provided an overview of the process of the Ad Hoc Redistricting Committee meeting, including an introduction from the CLA, opportunity for questions, clarifications, and amendments, and two opportunities for public comment. A representative from the Office of the CLA provided an overview of the Redistricting Proposals for the LAUSD Board of Education, and responded to questions posed by the Committee.

After providing two opportunities for public comment, the Committee recommended that the Council approve the recommendations in the CLA report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
