

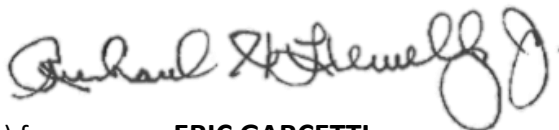

DISCUSSION

This donation will fund advanced domestic violence training and various service items for Detective Bureau in support of the Domestic Abuse Response Team (DART) program. The DART program pairs domestic violence victim advocates with specially trained Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) DART officers to respond to scenes of domestic violence incidents. These multidisciplinary crisis response teams work to provide both immediate assistance and long-term support to domestic violence victims and their families. Approval of this grant will fund the following:

- Advanced Domestic Violence Investigation Course – Identifying and Investigating Strangulation Cases: This two-day virtual course is presented by the Training Institute on Strangulation Prevention, a program of Alliance for HOPE International. DART officers, advocates, detectives, prosecutors, forensic nurses, and other domestic violence service providers will receive training to enhance their response to domestic strangulation crimes and provide the domestic violence service community with a coordinated response to these crimes.
- Secure Digital Forensic Imaging (SDFI) Software and Camera System: SDFI captures high resolution internal and external forensic pictures during sexual assault and domestic violence investigations. The SDFI software and camera system will be utilized by forensic nurses at the Los Angeles County University of Southern California Medical

Center Violence Intervention Program (VIP). Training for the forensic nurses on the use of the software and camera system will be provided by SDFI personnel. These forensic pictures are critical in domestic violence investigations, especially those that involve strangulation. In some cases, prosecutors will not file felony charges without pictures. Therefore, the SDFI software and camera system will improve prosecution of domestic violence cases.

- Poster Display Stands and Posters: Poster displays with information about the DART program and who the assigned domestic violence service provider is will be displayed in each of the 21 geographic Areas. The stands will contain brochures from the service provider for victims and community members to take for their reference.
- DART Car Cleaning: Emergency Response Crime Scene Cleaning will deep clean the interior of the assigned DART cars at each of the 21 geographic Areas once a year. The cars are used to transport victims and their children for services such as shelter, forensic medical exams, court appearances, and interviews. The cleaning service will help maintain the cleanliness of the DART cars and reduce the risk of contamination.

The Los Angeles Police Foundation is an independent, not-for-profit organization that provides critical resources and vital support to the LAPD. From essential equipment and state-of-the-art technology to specialized training and innovative programs that would otherwise be unfunded, the Foundation provides funding that directly improves public safety, impacts officer readiness, and enhances the quality of life of all members of the community. It is requested that Detective Bureau be approved for advanced domestic violence training, service and items including:
