Summary: In a regular monthly meeting of the Westside Neighborhood Council, the board voted to oppose the Council motion because while recognizing and strongly supporting the need for an expanded transit shelter program, the WNC believes that, given the scope of the proposed project and the many potential impacts of digital signage on public safety, it is inappropriate to seek clearance of the program through a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND). Rather, the Westside Neighborhood Council recommends that a full Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the program be done to identify possible negative impacts on public safety and the environment and to determine if mitigations can address these impacts or whether a project alternative is the best course of action.
