Recommendation for Council action:
AUTHORIZE the General Manager of the Information Technology Agency (ITA), or designee, to execute a contract with Frontier California, Inc. for telecommunications services for a term of three years retroactive from April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2024, with two one-year options to extend for a total compensation amount of $\$ 10.8$ million, subject to inclusion of language regarding COVID-19 vaccination requirements in the contract and the approval of the City Attorney.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that funding for the proposed contract is provided in the 2020-21 and 2021-22 Budget with the ITA's Communications Services Account. 2020-21 funding is currently encumbered for incurred expenditures within that Fiscal Year. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the above recommendation is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies as contract expenditures are limited to the appropriation of funds made by the City for this purpose.
