DRAFT ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 200.121 AND 200.125 OF ARTICLE 10 OF CHAPTER XX OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE TO REMOVE MALLS AND SHOPPING CENTERS FROM THE DEFINITION OF COVERED LOCATION, CLARIFY THAT THE ARTICLE APPLIES TO INDIVIDUALS 12 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER, AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF BUILDING AND SAFETY TO ISSUE CITATIONS, REQUIRE BUSINESSES TO POST A NOTICE OF CORRECTION OR ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION, AND MAKE OTHER TECHNICAL CHANGES

Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance would amend Sections 200.121 and 200.125 of Article 10 to Chapter XX of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to remove malls and shopping centers from the definition of covered location, revise the definition of individual eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine to specify that the article only applies to those 12 years of age and older, authorize the Department of Building and Safety (LADBS) to issue citations pursuant to this article, require businesses to place a notice of correction or administrative citation at the entrance to their establishment for 30 days, and make other technical changes.
