DRAFT ORDINANCE CALLING A PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION ON TUESDAY, JUNE 7, 2022, AND GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022, IN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES AND THE LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND AUTHORIZING CONSOLIDATION OF THE ELECTIONS WITH THE STATE PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS HELD ON THE SAME DATES

Honorable Members:

In accordance with Charter Section 402 and City Election Code Sections 104 and 106, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance calling and ordering the City's Primary Nominating Election to be held on June 7, 2022, and General Municipal Election to be held, if necessary, on November 8, 2022. We have approved the ordinance as to form and legality.

The draft ordinance calls the elections for the offices of Mayor; City Attorney; Controller; Member of the Los Angeles City Council for Districts 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, and 15; and for Member of the Board of Education of the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) for Districts 2, 4 and 6. The term of office for these City and LAUSD offices shall be for the full four-year term commencing in December of 2022.

The draft ordinance also authorizes consolidation of the Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections with the State Primary and General Elections held on the

same dates. If consolidated, the County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would conduct the City's Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections together with the State elections.

Pursuant to Council Rule 38, we have discussed the draft ordinance with the City Clerk's office.
