Summary: The STNC opposes CF21-1283 for the following reasons: • The City has endangered our Police and Firefighters by putting them on the front lines with possibly infected people during high rates of Covid 19 and Covid deaths by refusing to stop the rioting and protests threat which should have been stopped by Emergency orders.
