## **NOTICE TO APPELLANT(S), APPLICANT(S), AND INTERESTED PARTIES**

You are hereby notified that the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee of the Los Angeles City Council will hold a public hearing **telephonically** on **Tuesday, January 18, 2022** at approximately **2:00 P.M.**, or soon thereafter, to consider the following: Categorical Exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article 19, Section 15332, Class 32 of the CEQA Guidelines, and related CEQA findings; report from Central Los Angeles Area Planning Commission (CLAAPC), and an Appeal filed by Enrique Velasquez, Coalition for An Equitable Westlake MacArthur Park, from the decision of the CLAAPC in sustaining the Director of Planning's determination approving a Categorical Exemption, No. ENV-2020-5511-CE, as the environmental clearance for a proposed Transit Oriented Communities project involving the construction, use, and maintenance of a new seven-story mixed-use development, 92 feet and 6 inches in height, containing a total of 264 dwelling units, with 27 proposed dwelling units reserved for Extremely Low Income Households; the proposed development will contain approximately 266,438 square feet of floor area, including 9,724 square feet of ground floor commercial space; the project will provide a total of 22,137 square feet of open space comprised of public courtyards, a fitness center/sport lounge, patios, terraces, and private balconies; contains one subterranean parking level and ground level parking that will provide a total of 230 vehicular parking spaces (217 residential parking stalls and 13 commercial parking stalls); and, will provide 172 bicycle parking stalls; for the properties located at 2401-2417 West 8th Street and 729-751 South Park View Street.
