MOTION

The Fourteenth Council District (CD14) has received a request from the City of Ensenada to donate four (4) Combo Hydrojetter/Catch Basin Cleaner vehicles and two (2) dump trucks. On September 21, 2020, a delegation from the City of Ensenada, headed by Mayor Armando Ayala Robles, made an official visit to our City and expressed interest in our decommissioned vehicles. The City of Ensenada is located in Baja California, Mexico and is currently experiencing an emergency in light of the global pandemic.

Section 22.547 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) provides that upon Council approval, surplus City equipment may be sold for less than market value to a domestic or foreign government. The maintenance and disposal of the surplus equipment would also represent a net financial loss to the City of Los Angeles. The donation of four (4) Combo Hydrojetter/Catch Basin Cleaner vehicles and two (2) dump trucks will be used to provide services such as critical environmental services and public works projects within the City of Ensenada. The fair market value of the equipment is \$296,733.50, which will be forgone revenue should it be donated. Identifying information for the surplus equipment is provided below.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council find that the City of Ensenada is eligible to purchase four (4) Combo Hydrojetter/Catch Basin Cleaner vehicles and two (2) dump trucks, as listed above, at below market value (\$1.00), in accordance with LAAC Sec. 22.547 (Donation of Surplus City Equipment), as the recipient is a foreign government that is responding to an emergency, including, but not limited to, recovery or reconstruction efforts following a natural or man-made disaster; and


I FURTHER MOVE that the City Attorney be requested to prepare a contract to effectuate the sale and transfer of the surplus equipment identified above at below market value to the City of Ensenada; and

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be instructed to inform the City of Ensenada, Mexico [Efrain Kantel Sanchez, Director of International Affairs, XXIII Ayuntamiento de Ensenada, Carretera Transpeninsular, 6500 A, Ex Ejido Chapultepec, (646) 172-3401] that the surplus equipment must be claimed within 90 days from the date of Council approval of the request or from the notification of equipment availability, whichever occurs later, after which time it will revert to the City's surplus equipment pool for disposal by the Department of General Services.
