MOTION

The City was awarded a \$50,000 grant from the California Community Foundation Local Sustainability Matching Fund to implement Phase II of the Mayor's Great Streets Equitable Development and Healthy Communities Initiative. The City Council authorized the acceptance of this \$50,000 grant award and authorized the transfer of \$25,000 within the Mayor Fund for Salaries As-Needed (CF 14-1511). No matching funds were required as part of this grant award.

The second allocation of \$25,000 will be used by the Bureau of Street Services for improvements in Little Ethiopia on Fairfax Avenue between Olympic Boulevard and Whitworth Drive in Council District 10. The scope of work will consist of the installation of curb ramps on a midblock crossing to accommodate ADA accessibility. Construction is anticipated to begin in May 2022 and be completed by the end of Fiscal Year 2021-2022. While the City Council did authorize the acceptance of the full \$50,000 grant, the Controller was only directed to transfer the first allocation of \$25,000. Additional Council authorization is necessary to transfer the remaining grant funding to the Bureau of Street Services for the construction of the improvements on Fairfax Avenue.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council authorize the Controller to accept funds in the amount of \$25,000 from the California Community Foundation and deposit these funds in the Street Services Transaction Fund No. 64C, Department 50 for the construction of street improvements on Fairfax Avenue between Olympic Boulevard and Whitworth Drive in Council District 10.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council authorize the Controller to appropriate these funds to the Bureau of Street Services, Fund No. 100, Department 86, Account 001090 (Salaries, Overtime) in the amount of \$10,000, and Account 006020 (Operating Supplies) in the amount of \$15,000 to perform these improvements.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Streets Services be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above fund transfer instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this motion, including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers.
