





## RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize the Chief of Police, or designee, to execute First Amendments to Contract No. C-132405 with SketchCop Solutions, Inc., and Contract No. C-132406 with Anthony Kaklamanos to continue to provide composite artist services for the Los Angeles Police Department.

## SUMMARY

In April 2018, the Board of Police Commissioners authorized the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to negotiate contracts with the two bidders who responded to the Request for Proposals for police composite artist services. In November 2018, the Mayor authorized the LAPD to enter into three-year professional services agreements with SketchCop Solutions, Inc. (C-132405) and with Anthony Kaklamanos (C-132406) to provide these services. Each of the contracts were authorized for a three-year term beginning on January 1, 2019 and ending on December 31, 2021 for compensation not to exceed a total of \$60,000 per year.

Composite artist services include, but are not limited to: creating freehand drawings of criminal suspects from verbal descriptions from witnesses and victims; recreating a likeness of decomposed or mutilated

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faces and body parts as the result of a crime or accident; making freehand drawings of missing or stolen evidence or other items; and testifying in court as needed.

The Department is requesting authority to execute a two-year extension on each of these composite artist service contracts, beginning on January 1, 2022 and ending on December 31, 2023. The compensation for each contract is proposed to continue the same terms as the original contract at an amount not to exceed \$60,000 per year.

The 2021-22 Adopted Budget includes \$60,000 in the LAPD's Contractual Services account for composite artist services. Per Section 6.2 of each contract, it is understood that this annual appropriation is for all of the Department's composite artist services contracts. Funding for the contracts in subsequent years will be subject to consideration as part of the annual budget process. The proposed amendments require Council approval as the total proposed term for each contract exceeds three years.

### **FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT**

There is no additional General Fund impact. Funding for the proposed contract amendment is available in the Department's Contractual Services account as part of the 2021-22 Adopted Budget. Subsequent year funding will be subject to consideration during the budget development process.

### **FINANCIAL POLICIES STATEMENT**

The recommendation in this report complies with the City Financial Policies in that the City's financial obligation is limited to funds budgeted for this purpose.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. C-132405  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
AND  
SKETCHCOP SOLUTIONS, INC.  
FOR POLICE COMPOSITE ARTIST SERVICES**

This FIRST AMENDMENT to Contract No. C-132405 is made and entered into by and between the City of Los Angeles, California, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), acting by and through the Los Angeles Police Department (hereinafter referred to as the "LAPD" or "Department") and SketchCOP Solutions, Inc., a California corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") (each a "Party" and collectively, the "Parties").

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, on January 1, 2019, the City, acting by and through the LAPD, and the Contractor entered into Contract No. C-132405 ("Original Agreement") to provide police composite artist services to the Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Original Agreement, expires on December 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to enter into this First Amendment to extend the term for an additional two-year period, commencing January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2023, and to make certain other changes deemed necessary by the Parties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Contractor's services are of a professional and occasional nature and the Contractor has been providing satisfactory services; and

**WHEREAS**, this First Amendment is necessary to provide the continuous services of police composite drawings and other related art work under the Original Agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the City and the Contractor agree that the Original Agreement be amended as follows:

1. Extension of the Term of the Original Agreement. City and Contractor hereby agree that the term of the Original Agreement as set forth in Section 2.0 of the Original Agreement entitled "Term of the Agreement" is hereby extended for an additional two-year period, beginning January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023, unless terminated as provided in Section 9.0 of the Original Agreement.
2. COVID-19. Employees of the Contractor and/or persons working on its behalf, including, but not limited to, subcontractors (collectively, "Contractor Personnel") must be fully vaccinated against the novel coronavirus 2019 ("COVID-19") prior to (1) interacting in person with City employees, contractors, or volunteers, (2) working on City property while performing services under this Agreement, and/or (3) coming into contact with the public while performing services under this Agreement (collectively, "In-Person Services"). "Fully vaccinated" means that 14 or more days have passed since Contractor Personnel have received the final dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series (Moderna or Pfizer-

BioNTech) or a single dose of a one-dose COVID-19 vaccine (Johnson & Johnson/Janssen) and all booster doses recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Prior to assigning Contractor Personnel to perform In-Person Services, the Contractor shall obtain proof that such Contractor Personnel have been fully vaccinated. The Contractor shall retain such proof for the document retention period set forth in this Agreement. The Contractor shall grant Contractor personnel medical or religious exemptions as required by law.

The Contractor shall immediately notify the City in the event that any person who has performed services for the Contractor (including, but not limited to, employees, volunteers and contractors) at a site operated by the City, on behalf of the City, or under this Agreement, (1) has been diagnosed with COVID-19, (2) has been informed by a medical professional that the person is likely to have COVID-19, or (3) meets the criteria for isolation under the County of Los Angeles Public Health Officer Order for the Control of COVID-19: Public Health Emergency Isolation Order (April 1, 2020).

3. Disclosure of Border Wall Contracting Ordinance. Contractor shall comply with Los Angeles Administrative Code ("LAAC") Section 10.50 et seq., "Disclosure of Border Wall Contracting." City may terminate this contract at any time if City determines that Contractor failed to fully and accurately complete the required affidavit and disclose all Border Wall Bids and Border Wall Contracts, as defined in LAAC Section 10.50.1. The required affidavit must be submitted online at [www.labavn.org](http://www.labavn.org).
4. Ratification. Due to the need for the Contractor's services to be provided continuously, the Contractor may have provided services prior to the execution of this First Amendment. To the extent that said services were performed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Original Agreement, those services are hereby ratified.
5. Order of Precedence. In the event of an inconsistency between any of the provisions of this First Amendment to Contract No. C-132405, or all prior or current attachments, the order of precedence for interpretive purposes shall be:
  - 1) The paragraphs in the body of this First Amendment to Contract No. C-132406;
  - 2) The paragraphs in the body of the Original Agreement;
  - 3) Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev. 10/17) [v.3];
  - 4) Any other documents in the order in which they are attached.
6. Except as herein amended or modified, all terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect. This First Amendment includes three (3) pages. The Original Agreement is hereby incorporated by referend in its entirety into this First Amendment.

This First Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, and by the parties in separate counterparts, each of which when executed shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. The parties further agree that facsimile signatures or signatures scanned into .pdf (or signatures in another electronic format designated by City) and sent by e-mail shall be deemed original signatures.
