AD HOC COMMITTEE ON COVID-19 RECOVERY AND NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTMENT REPORT relative to COVID-19 Homelessness Roadmap unfunded temporary homeless interventions.

Recommendation for Council action:

DIRECT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to report on a funding strategy for interim housing sites that have been assessed and were determined to be feasible to support temporary homeless interventions.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that there is no impact to the General Fund as a result of the recommendation contained in the CAO report at this time. There is a possible fiscal impact to the General Fund as the CAO works to identify funding for the six projects that are currently unfunded. The full scope of that impact is unknown as only initial feasibility has been assessed and full costs are subject to final design of each project.

<u>Financial Policies Statement</u>: The CAO reports that the recommended action complies with the City's Financial Policies inasmuch as the CAO's Office was directed to report on a funding strategy for the unfunded projects.

## Summary:

At a Special Meeting held on February 22, 2022, the Ad Hoc Committee on COVID-19 Recovery and Neighborhood Investment considered a CAO report relative to a report back on COVID-19 Homelessness Roadmap unfunded temporary homeless interventions.
