INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Police Department, with assistance of the Department of General Services, the Department of City Planning, and the Los Angeles Department of Transportation, to identify and report with requirement parameters for a lot to accommodate the temporary storage of overflow unclaimed or salvaged oversized vehicles from Official Police Garages.

SUMMARY


At the meeting held on February 3, 2022, your Information, Technology, and General Services Committee considered a Motion (Blumenfield, Rodriguez - O'Farrell) relative to identifying requirement parameters for a lot to accommodate the temporary storage of overflow unclaimed or salvaged oversized vehicles from Official Police Garages. After an opportunity for public comment was provided, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion, as detailed above.
