

INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the revitalization of the Van Nuys Civic Center Plaza.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Martinez - Krekorian, Raman):

INSTRUCT the Department of Public Works to convene regular meetings that includes the Department of Recreation and Parks, Department of General Services, Department of Cultural Affairs, Los Angeles Neighborhood Land Trust, and other adjacent property owners to the plaza to:

- a. Establish an Memorandum of Understanding that shows ownership and maintenance responsibilities within the Civic Center.
- b. Establish a work plan for revitalizing the Civic Center Plaza that includes:
  - i. Renovating the plaza.
  - ii. Improving circulation and permeability between the plaza and surrounding neighborhood.
  - iii. Creating programing and engaging the local community and stakeholders.
  - iv. Placing the Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg Monument (Council file No. 20-1212)

Community Impact Statement: None submitted


## SUMMARY
