

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance amending Schedule A of Section 4.61 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to include and provide salaries for the new, non-represented classifications participating in the Bridge-to-Jobs Program.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Schedule A of Section 4.61 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to add Bridge-to-Jobs Program classifications in proper order as follows:

Sec. 6. Section 5 shall be operative on January 29, 2023.

Sec. 7. Schedule A of Section 4.61 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to add Bridge-to-Jobs Program classifications in proper order as follows:

9054	Community Services Representative Assistant	2035
9055	Community Services Representative Trainee	2035

Sec. 8. Section 7 shall be operative on June 18, 2023.

Sec. 9. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication, pursuant to Charter Section 252(g).

Sec. 10. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
