Re: Budget Modifications and Contracting Authorities for the FY 2019 (Council File No. 19-2020) and FY 2020 (Council File No. 20-1156) Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Programs

Dear Honorable Members:

Transmitted herewith for City Council consideration are proposed budget modifications and contracting authorities for the FY 2019 (FY19 UASI) and FY 2020 (FY20 UASI) Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) grant awards from the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS). On March 17, 2020, the City Council accepted the FY19 UASI grant in the amount of \$56,236,000 with a grant performance period from September 1, 2019 to May 31, 2022 (Council File No. 19-0695). On March 24, 2021, the City Council accepted the FY20 UASI grant in the amount of \$56,236,000 with a grant performance period from September 1, 2020 to May 31, 2023 (Council File No. 20-1156).

Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD)

Land Mobile Radio System Service & Maintenance

The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) entered into a sole-source contract (C-123897), a Master Services Agreement (MSA) with Motorola Solutions Inc. (Motorola) for the purchase of various services on an as-needed basis including field engineering, communications system design, system upgrade or expansion, project management, system technologist, field service, installation, programming, maintenance and support, and other services associated with the LAPD's various communication systems.

In FY19 UASI and FY20 UASI, the LAPD, as part of the City's Land Mobile Radio (LMR) System project, received a combined allocation of \$3,171,986.85 for service and maintenance support of the deployed LMR system. The LMR platform is used in support of patrol functions to enhance public safety. Upgrades to the system were funded with previous UASI grant years and included the hiring of Motorola for implementation services to expand the functionality of the existing Motorola ASTRO 25 m-Core Radio System and to transition radio operations to Project 25 Phase II compliant trunking architecture.

A total of \$3,171,986.85 has been identified from Fiscal Year 2019 and 2020 UASI grant awards to fund services and maintenance for the Project 25 TDMA Radio System Upgrade. The breakdown is as follows:

The Mayor's Office requests authority to negotiate and execute the 19th Amendment to Contract No. 123897, an MSA between the LAPD and Motorola, for the purpose of adding \$771,986.85 from FY19 UASI and \$2,400,000 from FY20 for service and maintenance support of the LMR System, for a term of up to 21 months within the grant performance period.

Emergency Management Department (EMD)

Texas Engineering Extension Service

In FY20 UASI (C.F. 20-1156, dated January 25, 2021) EMD received \$200,000 to conduct provide training in Jurisdictional Crisis Emergency Management (IMS-655), \$170,000 of this amount will be dedicated to a personal service contract and the remaining in travel expenses for students. EMD must enter into a sole source contract with the Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX), the only national provider for IMS-655. TEEX, via its National Emergency Response and Rescue Training Center (NERRTC) will provide one course offering for up to 55 students. The course will directly enhance the skill set of responders specializing in emergency operations throughout the Los Angeles-Long Beach Urban Area.

The Mayor's Office requests authority to negotiate and execute a contract with Texas Engineering Extension Service to provide emergency operations training in an amount not to exceed \$170,000 for a term up to 12 months within the grant performance period.

Ready Your LA Neighborhood (RYLAN) for Businesses

In FY20 UASI (C.F. 20-1156, dated January 25, 2021) EMD requested authority to update and expand on the RYLAN program to enhance business resiliency, emergency planning, and community outreach. The original project allocation was reevaluated for a

new smaller project scope and will be decreased from \$523,083 by \$275,083 for a new project allocation of \$248,000. The cost savings will be modified to other EMD projects pending grantor approval and no fiscal transfers are needed.

The Mayor's Office requests authority to negotiate and execute a contract with a vendor to expand the RYLAN program for businesses in an amount not to exceed \$248,000 for a term up to 12 months within the grant performance period.

Recommendations

It is therefore requested that the City Council:

1. Authorize the Mayor, or designee, to:
 - a. Negotiate and execute the 19th Amendment to Contract No. 123897 a Master Services Agreement with Motorola Solutions Inc., which was selected pursuant to an approved sole source procurement, for service and maintenance on the City of Los Angeles Land Mobile Radio System, for a term up to 21 months within the grant performance period, and for an amount not to exceed \$3,171,986.85, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
 - b. Negotiate and execute a contract with Texas Engineering Extension Service to provide emergency operations training for an amount not to exceed \$170,000 and a term up to 12 months within the grant performance period, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form;
 - c. Negotiate and execute a contract to develop the Ready Your LA Neighborhood (RYLAN) program for businesses for an amount not to exceed \$248,000 and a term up to 12 months within the grant performance period, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form; and
2. **Authorize** the Mayor, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to approval of the CAO, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
