

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE and ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND JOBS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$53,249,641 from the Office of the Governor's California Volunteers for Youth Employment Program.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

APPROVE the recommendations detailed in the March 15, 2022, City Administrative Officer (CAO) report, attached to the Council file, relative to the acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$53,249,641 from the Office of the Governor's California Volunteers for Youth Employment Program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations contained in the March 15, 2022, CAO report, attached to the Council File, will have no additional impact to the General Fund and will provide for the expenditure of the California Volunteers grant award for grant-related projects. Grant funds are budgeted to cover salary and related (overhead) costs for proposed positions within all departments with the exception of the Department of Recreation and Parks, which will reimburse the General Fund for related costs through special funds. No matching funds are required for this grant.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the City's Financial Policies require that the City pursue federal, state and private grants but strictly limit financial support of these programs to avoid commitments that continue beyond available funding. The recommendations contained in the March 15, 2022 CAO report, attached to the Council File, are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that all grant funds will be utilized for grant-eligible activities. All funding is subject to the availability of grant funds and funding determinations by the Mayor and City Council.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

On March 22, 2022, the Arts, Parks, Health, Education, and Neighborhoods Committee; and the Economic Development, and Jobs Committee, considered the March 15, 2022, CAO report relative to the acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$53,249,641 from the Office of the Governor's California Volunteers for Youth Employment Program.
