Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated March 8, 2022 amending LAMC Sections 187.02 and 187.03 to correct references relating to minimum wage provisions.

Summary:

On March 22, 2022, your Committee considered a March 8, 2022 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAMC Section 187.02.D to update references relating to the City's minimum wage annual increase. According to the City Attorney, the draft Ordinance amends LAMC Section 187.02.D to update references relating to the City's minimum wage annual increase. In 2017, the Bureau of Labor Statistics changed the geographic boundaries defining the Los Angeles price index, and also renamed the local price index. This amendment is necessary to the minimum wage annual increase can be properly implemented. The draft ordinance also amends LAMC Section 187.03.B to update the reference to the definition of a Transitional Employer. Section 187.03. B refers to Section 10.31.1 (h) of Article 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) for the definition of a Transitional Employer. In 2021, Article 5 of the LAAC was repealed as part of the consolidation and amendments to the local bid preference ordinances. This amendment is necessary to ensure LAMC Section 187.03.B refers to the correct LAAC section. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
