HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to supplemental youth set-aside goals for the City's Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention Program Round Two (HHAP-2) Grant Funding.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the following youth set-aside goals for the City's HHAP-2 Grant Funding:

- a. The City will increase its interim housing capacity to help reduce the number of young people experiencing homelessness in the City.
- b. The City will increase the availability of permanent housing solutions for youth experiencing homelessness to ensure a connection between interim and permanent housing for youth.
- c. The City will continue to engage its partners, including the Los Angeles County, the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, homeless service providers, community stakeholders, the State of California and the Federal government, to ensure strategic coordination of, and investment in, a comprehensive strategy to reduce youth homelessness.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that there is no impact to the General Fund or to HHAP-2 funds as a result of the recommendation in this report.
