





TITLE:

COMPETITIVE BID PREFERENCE FOR LOCAL CONTRACT BIDDERS.

THE ISSUE:

Shall the Charter be amended to allow the City, on a competitive bid contract, to award a bid preference to a bidder located in the City of Los Angeles?

THE SITUATION:

The Charter provides that competitive bid City contracts shall be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The Charter allows the City to provide a bid preference, but limits the award of a bid preference to a bidder located in California or Los Angeles County. The Charter currently does not provide for the City to award a bid preference to a bidder located in the City of Los Angeles.

THE PROPOSAL:

The measure would:

- Allow the City to award a bid preference to a bidder located in the City of Los Angeles on a competitive bid City contract.

A YES VOTE MEANS:

You want to allow the City, on a competitive bid City contract, to award a preference to a bidder located in the City of Los Angeles.

A NO VOTE MEANS:

You do not want to allow the City, on a competitive bid City contract, to award a preference to a bidder located in the City of Los Angeles.
