**DRAFT ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MICLA LEASE REVENUE COMMERCIAL
PAPER NOTES, TAX-EXEMPT SERIES A AND TAXABLE SERIES B,
AND APPROVING THE LEASE AND LEASEBACK OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY
IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, relating to the Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles Lease Revenue Commercial Paper Notes, Tax-Exempt Series A and Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles Lease Revenue Commercial Paper Notes, Taxable Series B (MICLA CP Notes) issued from time to time under an existing Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles Lease Revenue Commercial Paper Notes Program (MICLA CP Notes Program).

The draft ordinance approves the lease and sublease of certain real property (MICLA CP Notes Properties) by the City of Los Angeles, as lessor and sublessee, to and from the Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles (MICLA), as lessee and sublessor, in connection with the issuance by MICLA of the MICLA CP Notes. Each of the MICLA CP Notes Properties are currently subject to an ongoing lease and sublease (Existing Leases) relating to the MICLA CP Notes Program, and such Existing Leases are now proposed to be amended to extend the terms thereof and to release and remove certain real property therefrom, such that following such release and removal, only the MICLA CP Notes Properties would remain subject to such lease and sublease.
