RE: COUNCIL FILE TRANSMITTAL

On April 7, 2022, the Information, Technology, and General Services Committee considered a Bureau of Street Lighting report relative to a connectivity and digital inclusion update and proposal for Universal Broadband Services in disadvantaged communities, Council file No. 21-0600-S46. After consideration, the Committee moved to concur with the March 9, 2022 Public Works Committee's amended recommendations with the additional recommendation:

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Lighting, in partnership with the Civil and Human Rights and Equity Department and other members of the Connectivity and Digital Inclusion Working Group, to report on the issue of inequities in digital access (sometimes referred to as "digital redlining") and any data related to this issue in Los Angeles, particularly in regards to cost, speed, reliability, and other factors related to the quality and affordability of available internet service.
