Comments for Public Posting: I oppose the destruction of our precious ecosystems through the expansion of the LA Zoo. This would result in a significant loss of over 20 acres of native woodland habitat including 201 City Protected Trees and Shrubs, such as coast live oaks and toyons, and rare and a near-threatened California black walnut trees. All to turn the zoo into a theme park for visitors during the 2028 Olympics.
