SUBJECT:

Portion of Wilshire Boulevard Airspace between Spaulding Avenue and Stanley Avenue –
Resolution to Vacate - VAC – E1401310 – Council File No. 17-0545

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- A. That the City Council reaffirm its findings of December 3, 2019, including that it has imposed all the mitigation measures that are within the control of the City as described in the Final Environmental Impact Report (State Clearinghouse No. 2016081014) that are associated with the impacts of the street vacation.
- B. That the City Council reaffirm its finding of December 3, 2019, that no new information exists to show that the project or circumstances of the project have changed to require additional environmental review, as described in State CEQA Guidelines Section 15162, and therefore the existing environmental documents adequately describe the potential impacts for this airspace vacation.
- C. That the City Council reaffirm its finding of December 3, 2019, that this vacation is in substantial conformance with the General Plan pursuant to Section 556 of the City Charter.
- D. That the Resolution to Vacate No. 22-1401310 for this vacation be adopted.

DISCUSSION:

Resolution to Vacate: At the meeting of the City Council on December 3, 2019, Council conditionally approved this vacation request. All conditions of the Council's action of December 3, 2019, under Council File No. 17-0545 have been fulfilled. The Resolution to Vacate is being presented pursuant to Council instructions of December 3, 2019.

Resolution to Vacate No. 22-1401310 has been approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Environmental Considerations: The City Council, on December 3, 2019, found that it has imposed all the mitigation measures that are within the control of the City as described in the Final Environmental Impact Report (State Clearinghouse No. 2016081014) that are associated with the impacts of the street vacation. An Addendum to the Environmental Impact Report was prepared on February 2022. This Addendum analyzes proposed minor modifications to the LACMA Building for the Permanent Collection Project, as described and evaluated in the Certified EIR. The changes in the Addendum would not create any potential adverse impacts beyond those evaluated in the Certified EIR.

Los Angeles City Charter: The Council's action of December 3, 2019, complies with the requirements of Section 556 of the City Charter.
