

ADMINISTRATION EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to approving the First Amendment to Contract DA-5341 with Converjint Technologies LLC, to extend the term by 18 months, covering implementation, operation, and maintenance of the new Identity Management and Credentialing System of the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA).

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Airport Commissioners (Board) that the action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guideline.
2. APPROVE the First Amendment to Contract DA-5341 with Converjint Technologies LLC, to extend the term by 18 months, covering implementation, operation, and maintenance of the new Identity Management and Credentialing System of LAWA.
3. CONCUR with the Board's action on February 17, 2022, by Resolution No. 27433, authorizing the Chief Executive Officer, or designee, of LAWA to execute the First Amendment to Contract DA-5341 with Converjint Technologies LLC.
