ORDINANCE NO.	

Section 1. The Council of the City of Los Angeles hereby finds and determines that certain portion of easement for storm drain purposes hereinafter described, lying on 4930 Palomar Drive, is no longer required for the use of the City, and that the public interest, convenience and necessity require, and said Council orders, the conveyance by quitclaim deed of all the City's right, title and interest in and to said storm drain easement without notice of sale or advertisement for bids, to the person or persons who own the real property at the time of execution of the deed, in severalty, and upon the same tenure as their respective interests appear of record in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County.

Sec. 2. The aforesaid storm drain easement is located in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and is more particularly described as follows:

That certain easement for storm drain purposes, 15 feet wide, lying within a portion of Lot 5 of Tract No. 35696, as per map recorded in Book 959, pages 69 through 71, inclusive, of Maps, in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, dedicated by Tract No. 8200, as per map recorded in Book 114, Pages 62 through 65, inclusive, of Maps, in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County.

Sec. 3. The following is authorized and directed:

- (a) The Mayor of said City shall execute deeds in duplicate on behalf of said City, forever quitclaiming said easement above-described to the person or persons who own the real property at the time of execution of the deed;
  - (b) The City Clerk shall attest to and affix the City Seal to said quitclaim deeds; and
- (c) The Real Estate Group of the Bureau of Engineering shall record and deliver said quitclaim deeds to the grantees named therein.

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
