The Office of the City Attorney has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, repealing the original Ordinance of Intention (Ordinance No. 187457) and adopting a new Ordinance of Intention for the formation of the Greater South Park Business Improvement District (District).

Background and Summary of Ordinance Provisions

On March 29, 2022, the City Council adopted an Ordinance of Intention to consider the establishment of the District and levy of assessments on property owners (Ordinance No. 187457). The ordinance included incorrect dates for the public hearing and ballot tabulation announcement.

A new Ordinance of Intention is necessary to comply with the 45-day notice requirements of State law. Council File 22-0310 already includes the City Clerk Report dated March 15, 2022, related to the Ordinance of Intention. Therefore, we recommend

the adoption of the enclosed draft Ordinance of Intention for the establishment of the District. The enclosed draft ordinance also repeals the original Ordinance of Intention.
