

HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the adoption of a Watts-based Geographic Preference Policy for the Jordan Downs redevelopment effort in Council District 15.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Buscaino – Price):

REQUEST the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) to adopt a policy similar to the City of San Francisco's Neighborhood Resident Housing Preference for the Watts community as defined by the boundaries of the Watts Neighborhood Council.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on April 27, 2022, the Housing Committee considered Motion (Buscaino – Price) relative to the adoption of a Watts-based Geographic Preference Policy for the Jordan Downs redevelopment effort in Council District 15 in order to prevent gentrification and displacement. Representatives of Council District 15 and the Mayor's Office provided an overview of the matter. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to adopt the Motion requesting the HACLA to adopt a policy similar to the City of San Francisco's Neighborhood Resident Housing Preference for the Watts community as defined by the boundaries of the Watts Neighborhood Council. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
