BACKGROUND

On March 8, 2022, the Economic Development and Jobs Committee considered a Motion relative to the Summit of the Americas, which asked for a report on the Summit and insights about key policy themes. The Council adopted the Motion on March 25, 2022.

SUMMARY

The United States will host the Ninth Summit of the Americas the week of June 6, 2022 in Los Angeles with a focus on "Building a Sustainable, Resilient, and Equitable Future" for our hemisphere. As the only hemispheric meeting of leaders from the countries of the Americas, the Summit serves as the most important forum to address our region's shared challenges and opportunities. The Ninth Summit marks the first time the United States has hosted the event since the inaugural meeting in Miami in 1994.
