Subject: RESOLUTION NO. 22-9992 – PROPOSED APPROVAL OF THE FOREIGN-TRADE ZONE
OPERATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES HARBOR
DEPARTMENT AND INTERPORT LOGISTICS, LLC, FTZ 202, SITE 66

Pursuant to Section 373 of the City Charter and Section 10.5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, enclosed for your approval is Resolution No. 22-9992 authorizing approval of Foreign-Trade Zone (FTZ) Operating Agreement No. 22-9858 between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Interport Logistics, LLC, to operate its facility within FTZ No. 202, Site 66, located at 5560 61st Street, Commerce, CA 90040. The 1.1 acre property includes a warehouse and office space, approximately 21 miles north of the Port of Los Angeles. The Harbor Department, as the grantee, is required by the FTZ Board to have an Operating Agreement with FTZ site operators. The term of this proposed FTZ Operating Agreement is a term of five years with three, five-year renewal options. There is no impact to the General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION FOR CITY COUNCIL:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; and
2. APPROVE POLA Resolution No. 22-9992 authorizing proposed approval of Foreign-Trade Zone Operating Agreement No. 22-9858 between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Interport Logistics, LLC.
