

ADOPTED BUDGET RECOMMENDATION

Instruct the Bureau of Street Lighting to report to the Public Works Committee with a long-term plan to comprehensively address copper wire theft that prioritizes areas with an over-concentration of outages, particularly in the most disadvantaged communities. The report should address all potential solutions, such as the use of LED and solar-powered lights, the resources needed to prioritize equity and public safety concerns, identification of repeated patterns of light outages, and whether current prevention methods are sufficient to protect the street lighting infrastructure.
