MOTION

In response to requests from neighbors across certain parts of East Hollywood to install new trees where there are currently none or very few, Council District 13 is pursuing a project to this end in an effort to beautify but also improve and expand the urban canopy in densely populated neighborhoods in the District. New trees will help improve air quality, expand access to shade and help cool areas during the warm summer months.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to place on the Council Agenda for July 1, 2022, or soon thereafter as possible, the following actions for adoption:

- 1. Transfer / appropriate \$355,247 from the Council District 13 portion of the "Neighborhood Service Enhancements" line item in the General City Purposes Fund No. 100-56 to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74, Account No. 003040 (Contractual Services) for a program of installation of new trees coordinated by the Office of Community Beautification in an effort to beautify but also improve and expand the urban canopy in densely populated neighborhoods in the East Hollywood portion of Council District 13.
- 2. Authorize the Board of Public Works Office of Community Beautification to prepare, process and execute any required document(s) with Los Angeles Neighborhood Initiative (LANI), or any other agency or organization, in the above amount for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
- 3. Authorize the Board of Public Works Office of Community Beautification to make any technical corrections or clarifications as necessary to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of those instructions.
