Honorable Members:

As previously approved by this Council, the City Attorney engaged the law firm of Colantuono, Highsmith & Whatley, PC to assist the City Attorney's Office in the City's defense of a putative class action lawsuit based on allegations of Proposition 218 violations, entitled *Hoffman v. City of Los Angeles*, currently pending in the Los Angeles Superior Court.

This Office recommends that Council AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to increase the maximum compensation for Contract No. 139945 by \$50,000 for a new contract amount of \$150,000, such additional funding to be provided by LASAN from its Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund.
