**DRAFT ORDINANCE GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE AGREEMENT AND
GRANT OF UTILITY EASEMENT (OVERHANG TRANSMISSION) TO
SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON**

Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance would authorize the City of Los Angeles to enter into and grant to Southern California Edison (Grantee) a non-exclusive Agreement and Grant of Utility Easement (Overhang Transmission). The foregoing is in furtherance of the public purpose of the Landside Access Modernization Program at Los Angeles International Airport (Airport) and in support of aviation at the Airport, and is in the best interests of the public.

The Agreement and Grant of Utility Easement (Overhang Transmission) is in exchange for: (i) Grantee's agreement to replace, relocate, and re-configure three utility poles and associated power lines, equipment, and appurtenances (identified as poles 2115988E, 456606E, and 456611E on the City Property at the Southwest Corner of Arbor Vitae Street and La Cienega Boulevard) (Prescriptive Poles) with four new replacement poles as a result of replacement, relocation, and re-configuration; (ii) Grantee's permanent release and quitclaim of any and all alleged prescriptive rights it has or may have in and to the City Property, or any portion thereof, related to the

Prescriptive Poles; and (iii) Grantee's affirmative consent and agreement to recordation of Tentative Tract Map 74326 (Tract Map).

The overhang transmission easement area is approximately 2,203 square feet. This permanent grant will transfer to the public right of way upon recordation of the Tract Map.

A copy of the draft ordinance was presented to the Board of Airport Commissioners, and it recommends the adoption of the draft ordinance.
