## Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the President or two members, Board of Public Works, to execute to execute the proposed Amendment No. 5 to Contract No. 94375 with Responsible Biosolids Management for the beneficial use, loading, hauling, and transporting of biosolids at the City-owned Green Acres Farm in Kern County, CA. The Amendment will extend the term for three years with one three-year renewal option for a total term of six years and increases the cost ceiling by \$57,699,357 for a total cost of \$237,268,357. The current contract will expire on November 14, 2022.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that there is no additional General Fund impact. Funding is to be provided by the Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund. The Amendment contains a Financial Liability Clause which limits the City's annual financial obligation to the amount approved in the corresponding year's budget.

<u>Financial Policies Statement</u>: The CAO reports that the recommendations in this report complies with the City's financial policies as expenditures of special funds are limited to the mandates of the funding source.
