

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending Section 41.18 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to make it unlawful for a person to sit, lie, or sleep, or to store, use, maintain, or place personal property near schools and daycare centers; and to amend Section 56.11 of the LAMC to align it with Section 41.18 and to remove references to “Bulky Items.”

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated June 16, 2022, relative to amending Section 41.18 of the LAMC to make it unlawful for a person to sit, lie, or sleep, or to store, use, maintain, or place personal property near schools and daycare centers; and to amend Section 56.11 of the LAMC to align it with Section 41.18 and to remove references to “Bulky Items.”
2. INSTRUCT the City Attorney to amend the accompanying ORDINANCE dated June 16, 2022, attached to Council file No. 20-1376-S1, to change from the current radius to read as, “the end of all blocks within the radius of the designated location.”
