Comments for Public Posting: Please reconsider the repeal of the tenant protections in the city of Los Angeles. We are still in a pandemic, and with so many of our families still trying to recover emotionally and economically. Without the economic programs to create the safe net for housing, we will see more unnecessary evictions. We need more investment in community land trusts to preserve affordable housing in our immigrant and POC neighborhoods, infrastructure funding that helps mom & pop building owners upgrade and retrofit for energy savings, and an HCIDLA that educates and enforces tenant rights. As a long time tenant, and community gardener, I have been able to contribute to my Koreatown/Historic Filipinotown neighborhood. I helped co-found the White House Place Learning Garden, and helped young people finish high school and gain their first job experience through my time at the Bresee Foundation. Despite my contributions, I have personally suffered harassment and threats of eviction, only because I have lived in my rent control apartment for more than 21 years. It's wearing, and the worry + the stress of the pandemic and now the economy has contributed to my health issues. Tenant protections need to be extended, otherwise you are creating another public health disaster on the streets of Los Angeles.
